4. In what ways was the story of Jesus (a Jewish messiah martyred via crucifixion) unoriginal?
5. How soon did the "Jesus movement" begin after Jesus' crucifixion?
6. Characterize the rule of Pontius Pilate in the Roman province of Judea.
7. Luke's story of Jesus revealing himself to Peter and his companions on the sea of Galilee on the first Pentecost after Jesus' death is said to have resulted in "a collision between God and Rome." Explain.
8. In the Jewish tradition, what does "apocalypse" mean?
9. Apostle Peter, prepared himself and his companions to live in the apocalyptic age and in the way of Jesus. Describe this lifestyle.
10. Why the story of Jesus and the subsequent Jesus movement revolutionary? AND Explain how proclaiming a messiah/messianic age was a political claim.
11. After the stoning of Stephen (after he proclaims the slain Jesus to be a messiah) describe the role of Saul before his conversion?

12. What was the new radical "evangelist" mission of Paul after his epiphany/conversion?

13. Why was Antioch (modern Turkey) considered fertile ground for Paul's Jesus sect

14. What were the beliefs about the role of traditional pagan gods in the Roman Empire in the 1<sup>st</sup> Century A.D. and how did the Jesus movement pose a disruption and eventual threat to this?
